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1. The Board issued CFO&HWA order vide reference 1st cited, to M/s. Hospira Healthcare India Pvt. Ltd, Plot No.111 & 123 and 116, 117, 118 & 119, JN Pharmacy, Parawada (M), Visakhapatnam district with a validity period upto 31.12.2018 Under Sec.25 of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, under Sec.21 of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, Authorization / Renewal of Authorization under Rule 5 of the Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008.
2. The industry representation dated: 03.03.2017 vide reference 2nd cited for amendment of certain conditions of CFO order, enhancement of hazardous and non-hazardous waste quantities and revision in gardening water volume was placed before the CFO committee meeting held on 14.03.2017. The committee recommended amendment for enhancement of hazardous & non-hazardous waste quantities requested by the industry in their representation dt.03.03.2017.

3. As per the recommendations of the committee & request of the industry the enhancement of hazardous & non-hazardous waste quantities in CFO & HWA order vide reference 1st cited shall be read as follows:
